



BOIL WATER NOTICE

The Town of Bedford would like to inform citizens that we are still waiting for analysis results from a certified laboratory before being able to lift this notice.

Do not use tap water without bringing it to a rolling boil for at least one minute or use bottled water.

A purge on the temporary aqueduct network located in the Pins sector was carried out this morning in order to flush the problematic water pipes and improve water quality. Following this purge, other water samples were taken.

The situation is monitored very closely on a daily basis and the boil water advisory may be lifted as soon as several analyzes taken by a certified laboratory confirm that the water is drinkable and meets the quality standards in force.

In order to meet the needs of residents, the drinking water made available to citizens will now be offered at the Town of Bedford's drinking water reservoir, located at 50, Marziali Street. We invite you to bring your containers.

We apologize for any inconvenience caused by this operation and thank you for your understanding.
